Twining of schools "Partnership between schools "programme for Secondary and

Senior Secondary level schools in the State for the year 2022-23.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

The "Partnership between Schools" program aims to link the government schools of rural areas with the private schools and Higher Education Institutions to enable interaction amongst the students by sharing of experiences, exposure about various courses and opportunities for continuance of their higher studies. The Project Approval Board of MHRD has allowed the provisions for 3361 Secondary and Senior Secondary schools to conduct twinning program for greater exposure during 2022-23.

Hence I have been directed to convey the approval of the State Project Director to conduct the said programme. The details of the programme are given below:-

1. Rationale for the program:

The rationale behind this exchange program is that it offers a powerful alternative to four walled classroom chalk and talk methods. It lends to instilling a sense of awe which helps open young minds to introspection and new experiences. This initiative aims to explore this new dimension of learning which will provide and enable students to understand and respect cultural differences and help to create dedicated, committed, discipline and productive individuals.

2. Twinning of Schools Program Objectives:

- Capacity building: Twinning and partnerships can help strengthen the school staff and students involved through sharing or transfer of skills and knowledge.
- Identification of best practices: Twinning and partnerships provide opportunities to identify
 ideas, approaches, techniques and methods that followed in visiting schools and which can be
 shared and serve as inspiration for new initiatives.
- Added value, increased quality and effectiveness of school activities: Where the twinning and
 partnerships involve collaborating on a specific activity, it usually results in added value,
 more quality and effectiveness.
- Broadening of horizons: Twinning and partnerships help school staff and learners to broaden their views and be more outward looking, to break down barriers, to understand local specific cultures and to learn about their strengths and weakness.
- Relationship building: Twinning and partnerships can help build stronger relationships between student-student, student-teacher, and teacher-teacher of both schools.
- Mobility of teachers and learners: Twinning and partnerships are useful when schools want to create opportunities for mobility of teachers and learners. A partner school can host teachers and learners and behavioural change among students

5. Design of the Program:

- · To form a core team at district level.
- To select the schools for collaboration from each block.
- · To provide a rural school as partner to each urban school.
- To create an action plan for effective and similar conduct of activities.
- · To create a timeline and schedule to maintain homogeneity.
- To organize a joint meeting of the teachers of the partner schools for better mutual understanding and sharing ideas about the projects to be carried out.
- Schools should report back to each other at regular intervals and making the desired alterations and changes as and when required.
- Compilation and documentation of the entire process by each pair of partner schools jointly.
- Presentation of outcome & celebration.

6. Implementation of the Program:-

The partnership between schools and schools with higher institutions will be set up and ganized with the following manner:-

- Govt. Secondary or Senior Secondary school will have its partnership with Govt. Model School (Sarthak/Sanskriti) or Govt, Sr. Secondary school or Kendriya Vidyalayas or Navodaya Vidyalayas or Army school or other Central Government Schools or Private schools (Duration - One day).
- One Govt. Sr. Sec. school per block will pair with Govt. Model School (Sarthak/Sanskriti) or Govt. Sr. Secondary school or Kendriya Vidyalayas or Navodaya Vidyalayas or Army school or other Central Government Schools or Private school for the academic session i.e. upto March, 2023. Therefore, 119 Govt. schools will create partnership with 119 schools.
- Partnership between Govt. secondary and senior secondary schools with Higher Institutions (Duration - One day).

It is pertinent to mention here that the students will visit the higher education institutions such as ITIs, MITs, IIMs, Government Colleges, Medical Colleges, Pharmacy Colleges, Vocational Educational Institutions, and Technical Education Colleges etc. for a greater exposure of the students about courses/opportunities so that the students can decide the stream of higher education in academics or in technical streams.



- The DCT of each district will select all Government High Schools and Senior Secondary Schools of each cluster of a block for its twinning programme.
- The DCT will create a linkage with Higher Education Institutions available in respective blocks. Preference will be given to Government Institutions available in the block or nearby block.
- In case, a Girls' College/Institution is selected for twinning, only girl students of schools may be allowed.
- If a Higher Education Institution is not available in the block, Higher Education Institution of nearby block will be selected and so on. (District level should be the last choice).
- Two teachers (one female and male teacher) from visiting school will also accompany the students.
- The safety and security of all students be ensured.
- Due respect to all students will be ensured during journey from their school to Higher Education Institution.
- 9. Visit to Higher Institutions will be conducted on preferably on Saturday. The DPC will work but plan for each school visit to higher education institutions by contacting the colleges, institutions or medical colleges, engineering colleges, medical institutions, IIM, MIT, Universities available within block of district concerned.
- 10 A group of twenty students (5 students each from 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th) of Government senior secondary school with one female and one male teacher will visit the schools and higher education institutions as earmarked by the DPC concerned.
- If the school is Government High School- 20 students (IX & X) of GHS with one female and one
 male teacher will visit the schools and higher education institutions as earmarked by the DPC
 concerned.
- 12. The teachers nominated for the programme should have effective communicative skills.
- 13. The activities would be conducted with schools and Higher Education Institutions as per the theme and area as described for the programme.
- 14 All the BRCs will ensure that their respective blocks should complete their participation in the program per month from November, 2022 to January, 2023.
- 15. The DCT will prepare the detailed action plan for conduction of this program in accordance with the above mentioned guidelines and send it to the HQ before 24th November, 2022. The BRC will prepare the list of all Government Schools of their respective blocks and attach them with their nearby Higher Education Institutions as mentioned above. The same will be useful to DCT.
- 16. No objection certificates from parents be ensured.
- 17. Each school will submit one report to BRC in the following format:
 - Attendance of participants from each school, (class-names of student-roll number).
 - Photographs of students with captions (name of activity, name of student etc.)
 - At least one photo each of all activities.
 - Detailed feedback of 10 students from each school.
 - The principal must affix his stamp on every page of report and last page with signatures.


